Standards for Acceptance

One by One International desires to recognize all those whom the Lord is leading toward cross-cultural ministry. At the same time we wish to maintain appropriate standards for personal, spiritual, educational, and health qualifications. The following is a list of general qualifications in four key areas. In the case of married couples, it is important to know that the preparedness of each person is considered as well as the couple together. Both must meet the qualifications to be accepted.

Personal

- A passion to see people brought into God's kingdom
- Sensitivity to others and their needs
- Ability to adapt to new conditions and a new culture
- Spanish language competence
- Sense of humor and optimistic outlook (not required, but helpful!)

Spiritual

- A life that clearly demonstrates Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord
- Belief that the Bible is God's Word and is our final authority in all matters of faith and conduct
- A working knowledge of the Bible's content and major doctrines
- Agreement with One by One's statement of faith, vision and Lifestyle Covenant (www.obointernational.com/beliefs)
- Aspiration to exhibit character qualities consistent with those of elders and deacons (1 Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9)

Educational

- Level of education consistent with the anticipated focus of ministry
- Bible training, either formal or informal (church or personal study)

Health

- Evidence of social, emotional and mental stability (standardized assessments given)
- General good health (doctor concurrence)

Our missionaries fund-raise 100% of the cost of	their personal expenses. It is important for u	JS
to know the extent of the financial commitments	s you would bring with you into your service.

A missionary is not merely taking a job, but is making a total commitment to both his or her spiritual and personal growth and that of the people they will be serving. Missionaries need to be free to wholeheartedly invest their lives in ministry in Nicaragua. For this reason, we ask that missionaries make an initial 36-month long commitment to One by One and be willing to relocate to Managua, Nicaragua. We expect your first year on staff will be a period of adjustment and formation, language learning, and culture acclimation.
We also ask that our missionaries sign a Lifestyle Covenant, indicating their agreement to live lives that are honoring to God. In order to be effectively prepared for mission work, all first-year missionaries must attend New Staff Fund-Raising Training and dedicate themselves to their personal fund-raising efforts.

I am willing to make an initial 36-month long commitment to serve as a One by One missionary.

I understand that my failure to raise sufficient support in a reasonable amount of time may result in being disqualified to work with One by One.
I understand that I will be responsible for raising the full amount of my salary while I work for One by One.
I am willing to give up personal habits or attitudes which might be a stumbling block to fellow missionaries or national Christians, or which might lessen my influence as a missionary in certain situations.
I understand that upon acceptance to work with One by One International, I must submit

to its leadership over my involvement in ministry.
